TRAINING FUTURE FINANCE EXPERTS: ESSCA OPENS A SPECIALISATION ON ITS LUXEMBOURG CAMPUS

ESSCA School of Management is enhancing its **Master in Management (MiM)** on its Luxembourg campus with the addition of the **Financial Management specialisation as of the 2025-26 academic year**. Taught in English, this track prepares students to tackle strategic finance and risk management challenges. Located at the heart of one of Europe's financial centres, ESSCA is offering a unique immersive experience within a dynamic ecosystem where international banks, auditing firms and innovative companies operate in close proximity.

A programme designed for the world of finance

The Financial Management specialisation is offered as part of the Master in Management, a renowned, triple-accredited programme which has been awarded official Masters status from the Ministry of Higher Education and Research for the school's Luxembourg campus. This top-level training programme has been designed to meet the needs of companies from the area.

This specialisation covers a series of key fields of activity: **corporate finance**, **portfolio management**, **auditing**, **financial modelling** and **risk management**. Students alternate between theory and practice via interactive classes and case studies inspired by the working world. A **paid**, **six-month internship** completes the track, providing concrete immersion into a company.

Privileged access to leaders of the sector

Luxembourg is a major financial centre offering students direct access to major players such as PwC (with whom ESSCA has an exclusive partnership), Deloitte, EY, KPMG, UBS, Société Générale, Banque Centrale de Luxembourg, and Amazon.

In addition to the various courses, students also take part in **conferences**, **meetings with experts and company visits**, thereby enabling them to broaden their view on the sector and refine their professional project. This approach is conducive to rapid and successful entry onto the job market thanks to a number of career opportunities that encompass financial analysis, management control and risk management.
